

Creating Themes for LLEAP

Themes are the preprogrammed option for Manual Mode; they provide the consistency of preprogrammed simulations and the ability to adapt to unexpected learner actions. This two-hour virtual *Creating Themes for LLEAP* training will enable participants to identify the benefits of themes, operate the LLEAP while using themes, and program their own custom themes. This training will on create Themes using SimDesigner and not focus on any specific simulator.

The session is instructor-led and participants are welcome to ask questions via the platform's chat feature. Participants are encouraged to work with the SimDesigner and LLEAP software during this training. Upon completion of this training, participants should possess the skills necessary to program their own unique, custom themes.

SimDesigner is installed with LLEAP on all LLEAP Instructor PCs. A simulator is not required for this training.

- Provide a clear definition of a Theme
- Plan, organize, and author a Theme
- Navigate SimDesigner to program the Theme
