Creating Themes for SimPad_

Themes are the preprogrammed option for Manual Mode; they provide the consistency of preprogrammed simulations and the ability to adapt to unexpected learner actions. This two-hour virtual *Creating Themes for SimPad* training will enable participants to identify the benefits of themes, operate the SimPad while using themes, and program their own custom themes. This training will focus on Laerdal's SimPad Theme Editor software (download link below) and not necessarily on any specific simulator.

The session is instructor-led and participants are welcome to ask questions via the platform's chat feature. Participants are encouraged to work with Laerdal's SimPad Theme Editor software during this training. Upon completion of this training, participants should possess the skills necessary to program their own unique, custom themes.
